- 1. Backup Your Photos. Unlike with film, other than your hard drive you have no physical copy of you images. Copy them to CD or DVD and store them in another location.
- 2. Share your photos. Print them or publish them online. Share them with friends and family. Create a Photo Book or open a Flickr account.
- 3. Learn a new technique. Tutorials abound online for just about any technique you can think of.
- 4. Hone your skills. Practice by using only one focal length for a day, then only one shutter speed, aperture, ISO, etc.
- 5. Start a Photo of the Day or a Photo of the Week Project. Having a project can give you a reason to shoot more often.
- 6. Work on utilizing Off Camera Flash. "The only good light is available light, and by that I mean any light that is available" Joe McNally
- 7. Keyword your images. Windows Vista and 7 and I would expect the latest Apple OS to have this functionality built in.
- 8. Volunteer your time. There are many charities and organizations that could use the skills that you have.
