A Radical Change

am writing to you with a proposal for what is perhaps a radical change. I hope you will hear me out.

Most camera clubs in the NFRCC meet from September to April each year. That's not surprising. Traditionally, schools and clubs don't meet in the summer. This is because as recently as 1930, 40% of Canadians made a living from farming, and the summer months were the busiest - devoted to planting and harvesting crops.

But, that's not the case anymore. Other than perhaps a couple of weeks vacation, most people are around in the summer, working and carrying on as usual. It no longer makes sense not to meet in the summer. I am, however, not suggesting that our clubs meet year round. What I am suggesting is that we seriously consider changing our schedule so that we meet from March – November. My thinking is as follows: Western New York and Southern Ontario's winters are harsh. Roads are often treacherous. Darkness sets in very early. Getting to meetings during December, January and February is a hardship for many people, especially those seniors who don't see as well night driving. How delightful it would be to go to meetings in daylight, without worry about road and weather conditions!

What I ask is that you present my idea to your club members, talk about it, see what people think. Then discuss it at a meeting of the NFRCC. Maybe I'm not the only one who would like our club to 'shut down' in the winter months instead of the summer months.
