Rules

March 23, 2009

The rules, and judging information, relating to this competition are as follows:

- a) In the Colour, Black & White Print and Slide categories, exhibitors are permitted to enter:
 - 4 only Colour Prints and/or
 4 only Black & White Prints and/or
 4 Slides/Digital Images
- b) Slides, Colour Prints and Black & White Prints entered MUST BE THE SAME ENTRIES that were entered in the monthly competitions during the Camera Club year, i.e. September 2008 to February 2009.
- c) This will be an open competition. There will be NO SEPARATION RELATING TO ENTRY CATEGORY. i.e. Pictorial, Portrait, Nature, Photo Journalism, Creative, Action.
- d) Judging will be aimed at selecting top six (6) entries in Slides, the top six (6) entries in Colour Prints, and the top six (6) entries in Black & White Prints. From this selection process the Judges will then choose the slide of the year, the colour print of the year and the black & white print of the year.
 - 1st Place Print/Slide Of The Year
 - 2nd Place Runner Up
 - 3rd Place Runner Up
 - 4th Place Honourable Mention
 - 5th Place Honourable Mention
 - 6th Place Honourable Mention
- e) Please ensure that an entry card, with your name on it, is attached to the back of each print that is to be entered.

Also, please print your name & title of the image on the back of each print.

- f) Entry cards are also required for slide entries. However, please ensure that the maker's name and the title of the image are printed on the slide mount.
- g) For digital images, please email Karen Fulham the file names of your selected entries by March 8, 2009.
- h) The entries will be judged by a panel of 3 judges.

This competition is based on the Salon print enties. Members attending the convention may submit up to four (4) prints in each of the Colour or Monochrome divisions. The ten (10) highest scoring prints by at least five (5) different makers is the club entry. The highest scoring Monochrome and Colour club entries is awarded a **George Butt Trophy**.

Competition for Members: Slide & Print Salons

Print Salon Competition

Each Attendee may enter 4 color and 4 monochrome prints There will be 4 categories in each:

- Portrait
- Scenic
- Still life
- Open

(Images may be entered 1 in each or all in 1 category, etc.)

Awards will be:

- 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place in each category, and from those 12, a best in show (in both Color & Monochrome)
- Judges choice Award —— each judge will choose their favorite image
- Peoples' Choice Attendees will determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in both Color and Monochrome. Ballots will be included in the registration packets.

Digital Projected Images

Members may enter up to five (5) images as follows:

Pictorial Division - 2 images

Nature Division - 2 images which follow the NFRCC rules for Nature entries

Wildlife Division - 1 image of pure wildlife. The first place winner is awarded the **Diane Payton-Majumdar Trophy.**
