The Owners will allow our group to enter their very large vintage auto yard for a few hours to capture some remarkable images of some very old vehicles. There is a wild variety of unique vehicles spanning several decades that have been on the property so long that the trees have grown around and through the vehicle skeletons.

This place is a treasure to say the least. The trip will take most of the day (bring lunch and liquids) as the location is 1.5 to 2 hours north, located just south of the corner at 12584 Fourth Line Nassagaweya, Rockwood, ON. NOB 2KO (south of the corner and west side of the road) Parking is at a premium so car pooling is required where possible. No parking on roadside so owners have arranged green field parking (based on a rough vehicle count for our group.)

We will be collecting \$10 per person at the location before entering as an honorarium to the owners. Limited attendance may restrict us to paid club members only.

All members will be required to sign our liability waiver before entering the property.

Care must be taken by participants while wandering through, viewing and photographing items to prevent injury. An attendee count will be checked at the end to ensure all participants have returned safely. Winter type clothing and rubber/waterproof boots should be worn due to weather and ground conditions.

Members must provide verification of attendance in advance for our vehicle and attendee count to the owners a few days before the 13th.
