Digital files are to be named using the following five fields: Category, Level, Entry Number, Member's name & Image name. The fields are separated by the Underscore symbol (_)

Entry Numbers: Two digit numbers between 01 and 12

Month	September	October	November	December	January	February
Entry Number	01, 02	03, 04	05, 06	07, 08	09, 10	11, 12

The file naming format is:

Category_Level_Entry Number_Member's Name _Image Name

For example:

1.Mary Smith is a member entering her first competition. She titles her first entry as follows:

P_B_01_Mary Smith_Lighthouse at Dusk

2.John Henry is at the silver level and has a nature entry. It is his second entry in November (i.e. his 6th entry for the year) The file will be named as follows:

N_S_06_John Henry_ Snoopy Raccoon
