
2023 NFRCC Exceptional Service Award

POWER & A PINT NIAGARA PARKS POWER STATION 7005 Niagara Parkway, Niagara Falls Sat March 25, 2023 @ 3:00 Counterpart Brewery @ 5:30 3659 Stanley Ave, Niagara Falls

Explore the first major power plant on the Canadian side of the Niagara River with immersive exhibits, restored artifacts and interactive storytelling. Then descend 180 feet in a glass-panelled elevator and explore the 2,200-foot long tunnel, leading to an observation deck at the river's edge. Find out how this remarkable tunnel was excavated with only lanterns, rudimentary dynamite, pickaxes and shovels. Wear comfortable shoes and dress for the weather. It is chilly at the tunnel and be prepared to get wet once you reach the observation deck at the river's edge. Admission and Guided Tour is recommended \$38. There are a limited number of tickets available at 3:00 so please reserve early. General admission is \$28 per person. Tickets for the guided tour must be purchased online at

There is parking available at the Power Generation Station. If you have a Niagara Parks Parking Pass, parking is at no charge.

After the experience at the Power Station, take a drive on over to Counterpart Brewing for dinner and a pint. Counterpart Brewery is a craft brewery and kitchen located in an industrial plaza in the north end of Niagara Falls. They produce a wide variety of progressive and inspired beers and offer an eclectic array of house made dishes that showcase both creativity and technical proficiency. Their service style and layout were created with a casual and social experience in mind.
