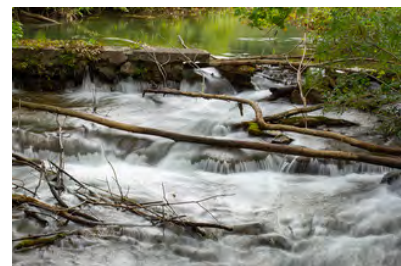
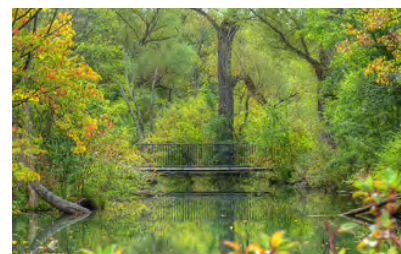
Although this is not a planned group outing for NAPA, some of you might be interested in attending the following event.

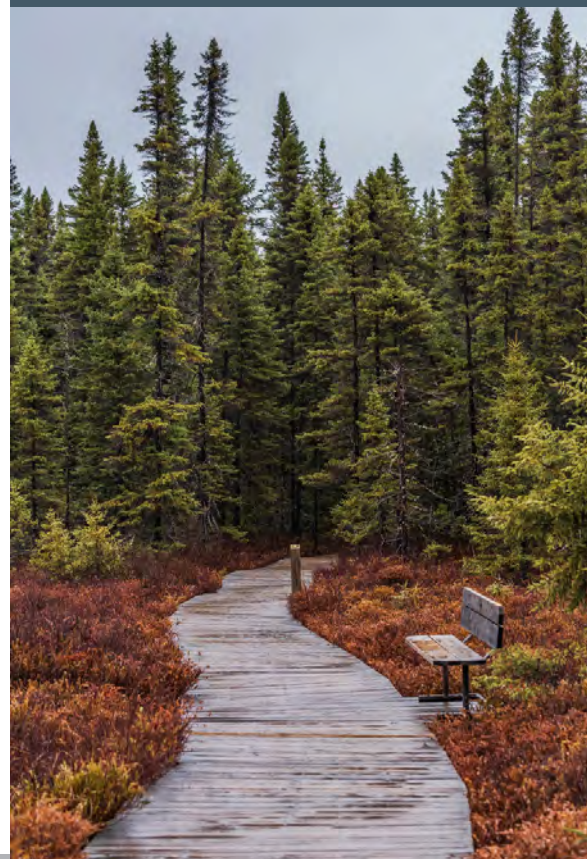
