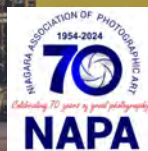

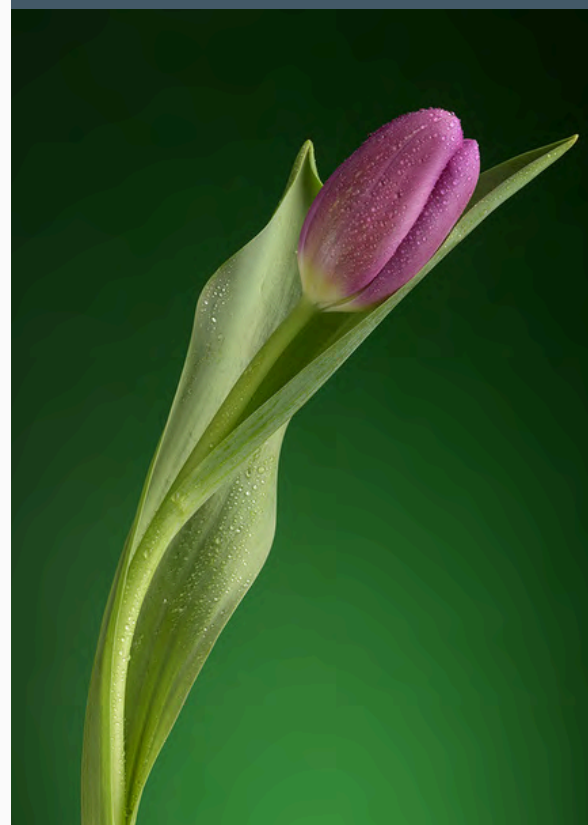

All three had several other images listed as Acceptances.

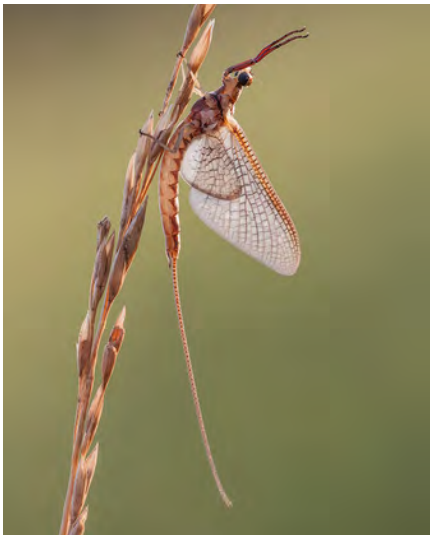

The city of Hamilton restored Dundurn Castle’s 40 rooms to match its historic interior when the wealthy Sir Allan MacNab lived there. Today, the castle operates as a museum, depicting what daily life for the MacNab family was like at that time. It also offers insights into 19th century life in Hamilton and throughout Ontario. Interpreters and hosts dressed in costume will guide you through the castle’s rooms and grounds. During November the Castle will be decorated for Christmas.

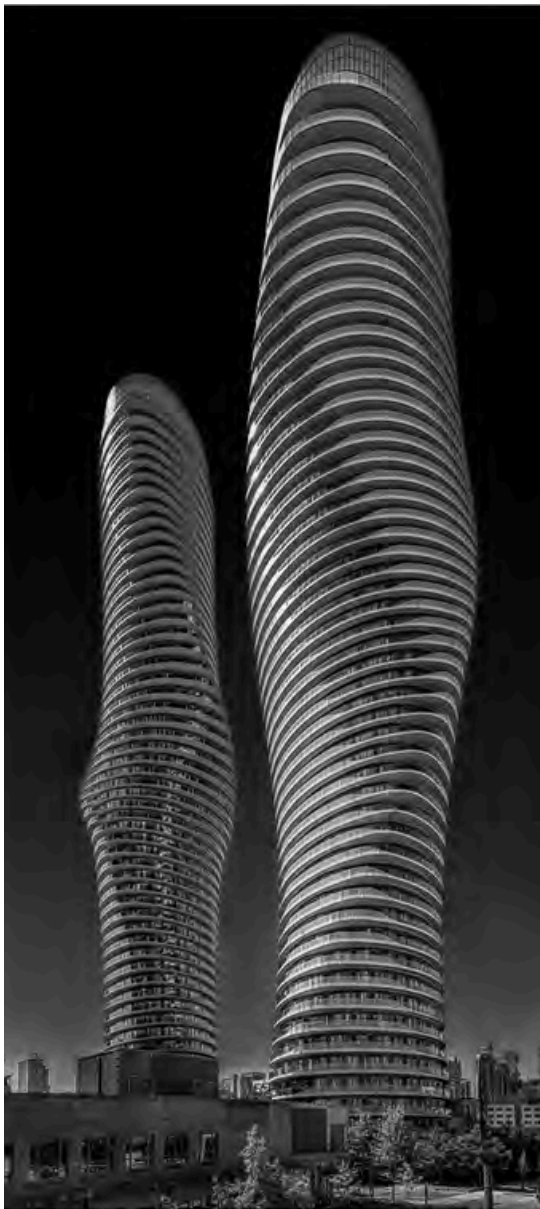
