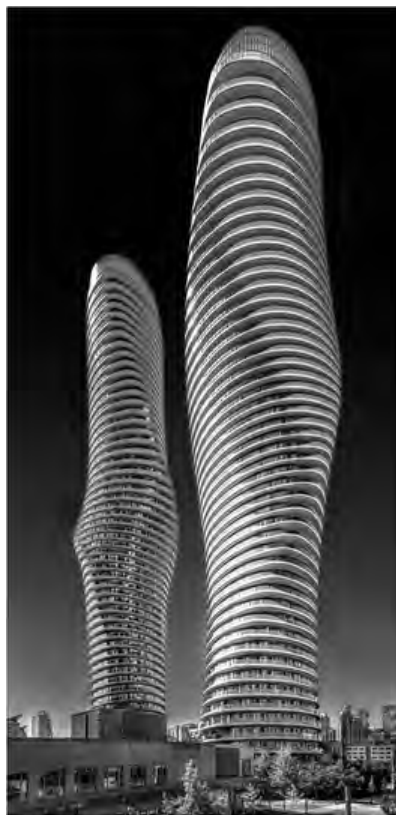

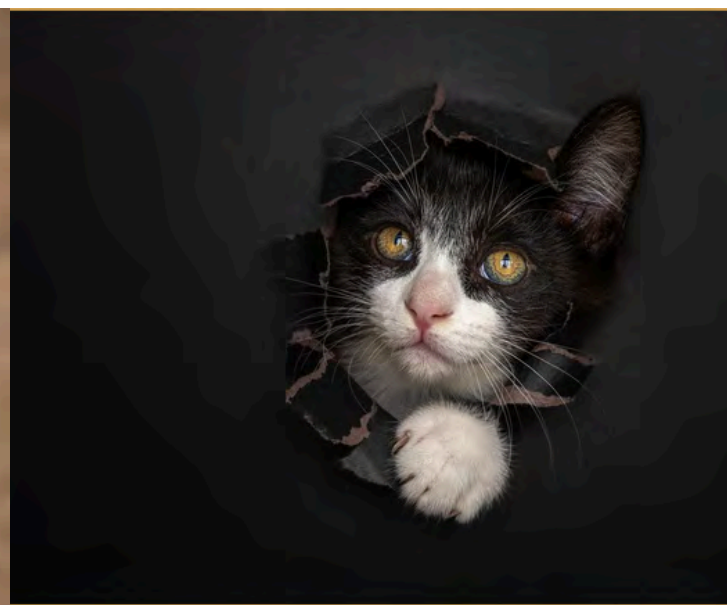

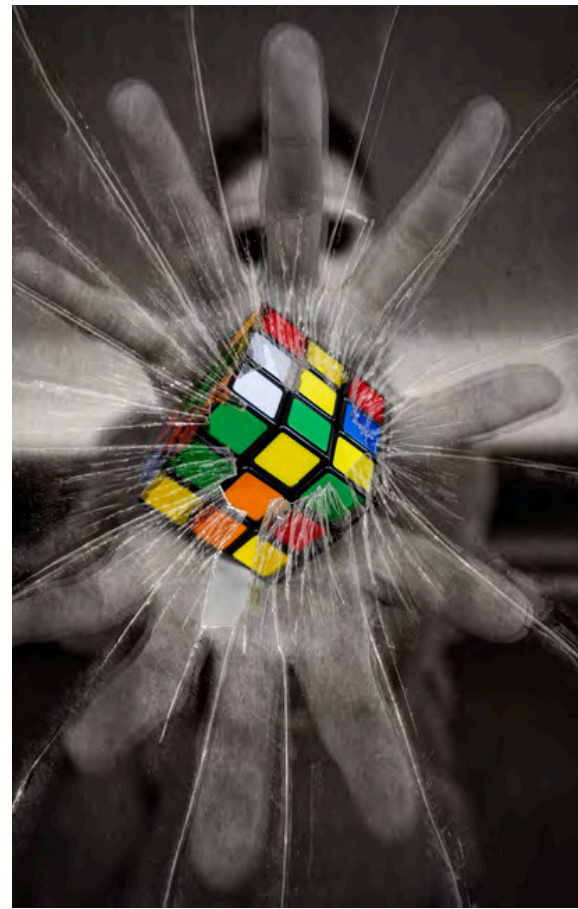

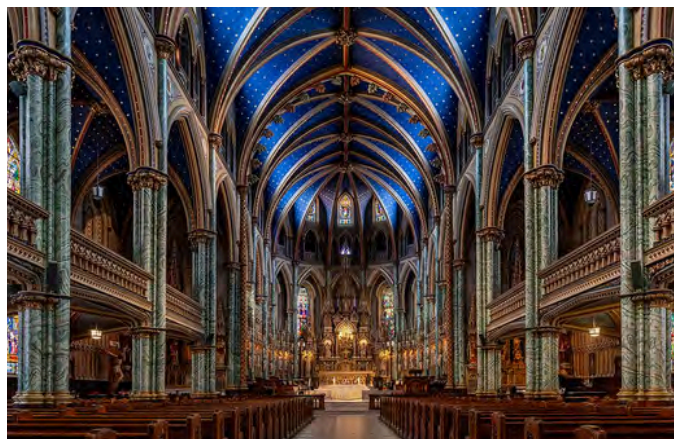

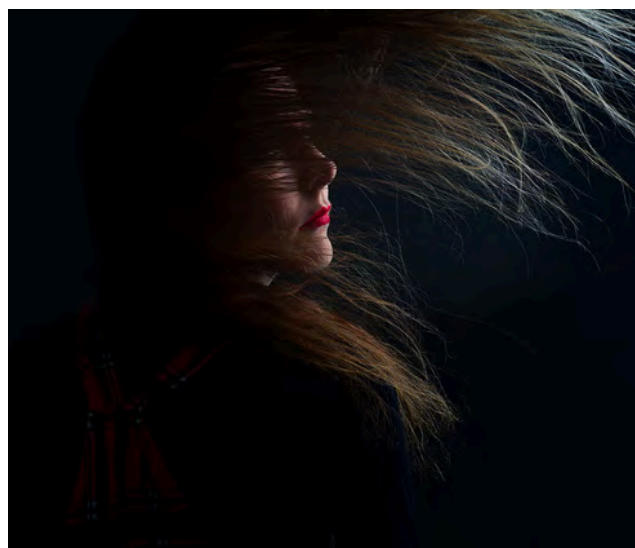

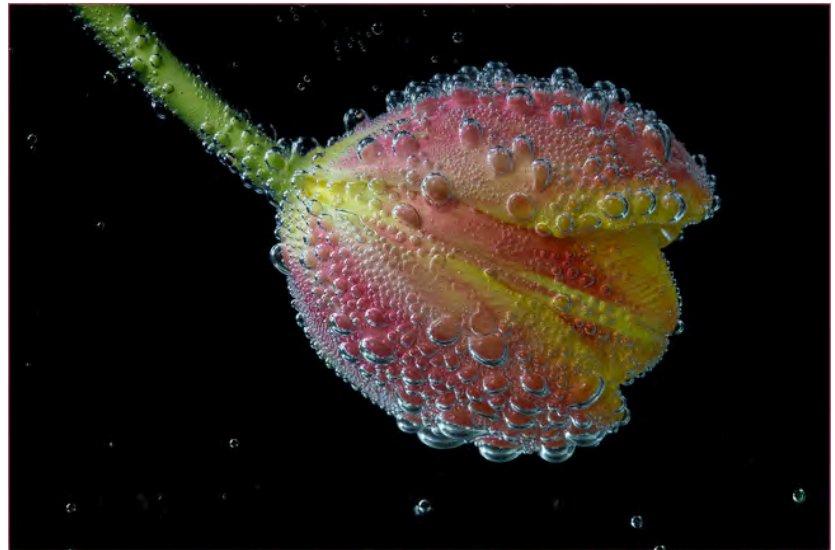
Congratulations to all, on your display of Photographic Art
